Hello Mark,

I installed the Fitch Fuel Catalyst in my 1996 Crown Victoria LX. The car had approx. 198,948 miles. The vehicle as of today, 3/19/10, has approx. 223,756. The Fitch Fuel Catalyst was purchased in Nov of 2008 and has been installed on the vehicle since. Average MPG is 24-25, going 60mph, no A/C, windows up, 2 passengers on the vehicle.

My personal opinion is that this product has worked efficiently, and increased gas mileage when given proper maintenance. Oil changes were done on time, filter/fluids, etc were done and no major "performance" upgrades were made. (Motorcraft Fluids, Filters, Spark Plugs, etc.)

Please note that when the fuel filter was changed, that is when the most MPG increase was noticed. All of this was achieved with 87 octane only. No additives, cleaners, etc.
